### **Underperforming & Gatekeeper Course List**

#### Method

This report is produced using Course warehouse files at the end of term. Bozeman students were excluded, as were null grades. PCE courses (094 and 194) were excluded. Success for this report is defined as an A, B, C, P, or CR grade.

**Developmental coursework** is excluded from the underperforming course list. The reasoning of the committee was that developmental coursework is being monitored in various other ways - through the Common Ground Initiative, in the Core Indicators, and in other institutional reports. Developmental coursework *is* included in the gatekeeper course list - since this list is primarily interested in coursework that stops students from progression in their respective programs, it was felt appropriate to include these courses here.

# Summary

The average success rate for all courses taught at MSU-Great Falls is **75.4%.** The courses listed in the **underperforming course list** are those 10 courses with the lowest average success rates over the last three academic years.

The **gatekeeper course list** includes those courses with substantial enrollments (over 100 students during a single academic year) whose success rates are lower than the institutional average. There are currently 15 courses on this list - the number of courses on the list may change if more or fewer courses meet the criteria specified on the report page.

Some courses appear on both lists - these are course of particular concern, where enrollments are high and success rates are low. For the academic year 2013-2014, these courses are:

Accounting Procedures I
Introduction to Business
Basic Human Biology
Human Anatomy & Physiology I
Introduction to Computers
College Algebra

College Writing I

In addition, please note that while developmental courses may appear on the gatekeeper course list, developmental courses were *excluded* from the underperforming courses list. Four of these courses (M 065, M 090, M 095, and WRIT 095) would appear on both lists if not for this exclusion.

## Comparison to Last Year's List

**WRIT 101** 

Of the 10 courses on the original list, seven of those remain on this year's list as well. Of those, **three** have increased their success rates, and the other four have lower rates. These changes range from an **increase** of **seven** percentage points for **BGEN 105** to a **decrease** of **four** percentage points for **BIOH 104**.
