I. Scope of Program

Montana Tech and Great Falls College - University of Montana hereby establish an articulation agreement leading to a Bachelor's of Science Degree for Registered Nurses. The degree will be conferred by Montana Tech.

II. Length of Agreement

This agreement will begin in the fall semester of 2018. The parties commit to a review every other year. The next review will be fall 2020.

III. Course Articulation

RN Nursing students completing the Associate of Science degree in Registered Nursing at Great Falls College and licensed in the State of Montana will be granted 72 semester credits. Graduation from Montana Tech in nursing requires completion of 15 credits of general education courses, some of which may be part of the 72 credits transferred from Great Falls College. The student must earn a total of 120 credits in order to graduate from Montana Tech. Upon completion of the program courses and the meeting of all graduation requirements including the general education requirements, a Bachelor of Science degree in Registered Nursing will be awarded.




